

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT:
On Tuesday, August 10th, at 7:00 p. m. at the Erlanger branch of the Kenton County Public Library, the Kenton County Historical Society will hold its monthly meeting. This program will be open to anyone sincerely interested in regional and local history. Welcome!

The time for publishing the first issue of Northern Kentucky Heritage was postponed, and is now scheduled for September.

So at this our August 10th meeting, Karl Lietzenmayer, head of our editorial board, will discuss issues and considerations regarding content. Sharon Pigg, computer and marketing specialist, will discuss style and layout. Rene Thompson, genealogist, will talk about content for the family history page. All aspects of this exciting new source of history will be open for comment and opinion.

Presently we have about seventeen persons who have signed on for our editorial board. These include one or more professional journalists, two librarians, and several educators. Campbell, Gallatin, Grant, and Kenton Counties are represented on our board. We would like to have representatives and contributors also from Boone, Carroll, Owen, and Pendleton counties. It is proposed that Northern Kentucky Heritage cover the history in any of the eight counties mentioned here.

At the August meeting of the Kenton County Historical Society, members will be asked to vote on proposed amendments to the bylaws whereby membership and/or subscription would be offered according to this schedule: Individual including subscription:\$25.00; student and senior citizen--\$20.00; institutional--\$30.00; professional and business--\$100-200.00; lifetime--\$150.00 plus \$15.00 per year for subscription; subscription without membership--\$20.00; membership without subscription--\$10.00.
